Some things to keep near and gear to your heart

Your Basic Caving Needs

- Clothing
- LightSSSSS
- Helmet
- Water (Bobby say it please)

Clothing



- Should be quick dry and durable
- Gloves
- Must be washed and cleaned before entering
- Should cover all of legs and torso to reduce exposure of oils
- Knee Pads over pants to reduce wear

Lights



- Always keep 2 on your helmet
 - One main / One backup
- Always keep spare batteries and know where they are
- Higher powered headlamps require battery changes frequently
 - 18650's can last as short as2.8 hours in zebra lights

Helmets



- Suspension based
 - Easy to clean
 - Can be uncomfortable
- Hybrid foam/suspension
 - Decently comfortable
 - More difficult to clean
- Foam
 - Comfortable
 - Wear easily so basically useless

Advanced Gear

- Vertical Equipment
- Bags
- Risk mitigation supplies

Vertical Gear

Should be set up as follows:

- Cows Cows Tails
- Can Chest Ascender
- Hardly Hand Ascender
- Read Rack (Or other descent device)









Bags



- Important factors when selecting a bag
 - o Form
 - Sanitation requirements
- While there are good bags specifically designed for caving, bags in other markets can suffice
 - If you want to get a cave bag ask someone for advice

Risk mitigation

- Caving can expose you to hazards such as
 - Hypothermia
 - Overexertion
 - Falls



- Extra clothing or emergency blanket
- Extra water / electrolytes
- First aid equipment
 - Sam splints
 - Bandages
